**COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES**

**MINI-CASSIA BOARD OF COMMUNITY GUARDIANS**

Ray Koyle met with the Board and presented the Mini-Cassia Board of Community Guardians annual report. The Board also discussed Board members terms that have expired.
