

#505 COMMISSIONER MINUTES July 01, 2002

COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES

The minutes for June 24, 2002, were discussed. The motion was then made and seconded to approve with corrections and proceed with publication. Voting was unanimous by the Board.

CALENDAR

The Board reviewed the calendar for July 2002.

BID OPENING SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

Kent Searle met with the Board and presented bids to purchase additional radios for 911 service. Following review it was moved and seconded to purchase from All Wireless in the amount of \$4904.00. Voting was unanimous by the Board.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
