

HEARING FOR CANCELLATION OF TAXES
FOR BRUCE AND MARTY BEDKE

The Cassia County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing today to consider cancellation of taxes for property owned by Bruce and Marty Bedke. Chairman Dennis Crane, Paul Christensen and Clay D. Handy, Board Members; Alfred E. Barrus, Prosecuting Attorney; Kerry D. McMurray, County Administrator; Joseph W. Larsen, Clerk of the Board; Robert Kunau, Commissioner-elect; Patty Justesen, Deputy County Treasurer; and Marty Bedke, were present.

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crane at 10:05 a.m.

CANCELLATION OF TAXES HEARING

Marty Bedke explained the situation of a trailer located on property they purchased and inhabited by an elderly renter that they were requesting cancellation of taxes on. The renter recently died and the trailer on their property was in such a condition that it needed to be destroyed. Following discussion of the Board with Mrs. Bedke, Commissioner Handy made a motion to waive the solid waste assessment on that property for 2010 and 2011, seconded by Commissioner Christensen. Commissioner Crane, Handy, and Christensen all voted yea.
