The Cassia County Board of Commissioners held a nitrate summit meeting as part of their regular public meeting day on the 25th of January, 2009 at the Burley City Hall Council Chambers, 1401 Overland Ave. Burley, Idaho. Chairman Dennis Crane, Paul Christensen and Clay D. Handy, Board Members; Alfred E. Barrus, Prosecuting Attorney; Kerry D. McMurray, County Administrator, and Stella Sutherland, Deputy Clerk, were present for Cassia County.

Howard Neibling of University of Idaho gave a presentation on Operational Nutrient Management.
