

PROPOSED CASSIA CREEK ELECTION HEARING
November 15, 2010

The Cassia County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing today to determine the sufficiency of the petition for the proposed Cassia Creek Irrigation District. Chairman Dennis Crane, Paul Christensen and Clay D. Handy, Board Members; Alfred E. Barrus, Prosecuting Attorney; Kerry D. McMurray, County Administrator; and Joseph W. Larsen, Clerk, were present.

INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting was called to order at 11:30 a.m. with introductions taking place of those in attendance.

HEARING ON PROPOSED ELECTION TO ESTABLISH
THE CASSIA CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT

The Board held a public hearing on the proposed election to establish the Cassia Creek Irrigation District. It was opened to public discussion and comment by Chairman Crane. A petition and comment was presented by the proposed district's attorney, Matt Darrington which was reviewed by Prosecutor Barrus. Barrus expressed concern whether or not the statutory requirement of signatures had been met. Commissioner Handy made a motion that the hearing be continued to allow for research regarding sufficiency of the petition before proceeding; seconded by Commissioner Christensen; followed by Commissioner Handy, Chairman Crane, and Commissioner Christensen all voting yea.
