



**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER MINUTES**  
**September 19, 2011**

The Cassia County Board of Commissioners met this day with Chairman Dennis Crane, and Bob Kunau, Board Members; Al Barrus, County Prosecuting Attorney, and Susan Keck, Welfare Director/Deputy Clerk of the Board, present.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION**

At 11:04 a.m. it was proposed by Commissioner Kunau and seconded by Chairman Crane that the Board convene in Executive Session under Idaho Code Section 67-2345(1)(d) with Chairman Crane voting yea and Commissioner Kunau voting yea. The purpose and general tenor of the meeting was to discuss medical indigent matters. Welfare Director Susan Keck presented Case # 2011-103 to the Board. Following the discussion, the Board returned to regular session at 11:08 a.m.

Chairman Crane read a letter from County Road Supervisor Sam Adams, regarding the status of various county road projects, including culverts, and bridge projects. It was noted that on September 26, 2011, the Narrows Road will be closed temporarily while culverts are replaced.
