November 01, 2012: Special Session: A meeting was held with the Gateway Task Force, approval of computed amendments for the 2012 property tax collection for the City of Burley and the Cassia School District. The Board also moved to approve comments and opinions proposed on behalf of the Gateway Task Force by attorney Doug Balfour.

November 05, 2012: Approvals: Amendment to Agenda, Letter of recommendation for considerations of a grant for the Weed and Pest Department, Change of Status requests, Minutes from October 29, 2012, 69 CSI Residency Applications, Road Report, Letter to ITD to be considered for equipment purchase, upgrade to an Executive Business Membership Card with Costco, and transfer of accrued time from one employee to another.
