

CASSIA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SYNOPSIS OF MINUTES JULY 2013

July 1, 2013: Approvals: Change of Status Request, employee time sheet and overtime, minutes from June 24, 2013, 6 CSI Residency Applications, two beer and liquor licenses, Second Level Conflict Public Defender Contract, Request For Proposal to re-caulk the exterior precast concrete walls and increase the number of hours worked by six in the contract with the Veteran's Service Officer Georgianna Greenwell. At 9:31 AM The Commissioners moved to go into the Board of Equalization re: the appeal of assessed value of property owned by MAD properties which was taken under advisement. After Findings of Facts and Conclusion of Law as presented by Prosecutor Barrus the appeal of MAD Properties was denied. The BOE also moved to accept Pacific Ethanol's recommendation for valuation of \$56,000,000. At 2:36 PM the Commissioners moved to go into Board of Equalization re: approval of valuations as presented by the Assessor's Office for Five River's Enumerated Properties and they approved the Assessor's Office proceeding with property splits despite a difference in the value of the parcel.

Executive Session re: Indigent Matters; Mrs. Keck presented details about an appeal and presented one case. The Board signed one Certificate of Denial, one Certificate of Approval, five Notice of Lien and Applications for Medically Indigent benefits, three Notice of Continuances, two Release of Medically Indigent Liens and one Determination of Decision Held in Suspension. 9:10 AM The Commissioners moved to go into the Board of Equalization re: accept the Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law and decision regarding the appeal of Pacific Ethanol Magic Valley, LLC. 11:14 AM the Commissioners moved to go into Board of Equalization re: acceptance of the Assessor's property assessment on aforementioned property and support Findings of Facts and Conclusion of Law.

July 15, 2013: Approvals: Change of Status Request, time sheets as presented, Minutes from July 8, 2013, seven CSI Residency applications, Auditor's Office Policy for submission of payables as presented and for department heads to timely submit request for payments on time-sensitive payables, beer and liquor licenses as presented, mileage reimbursements for Fair Board members and Cory Parish, purchase of a commercial laundry washer from Mendenhall Commercial Laundry Equipment for \$5,500.00 and voting places for the August 27, 2013 election. Executive Session re: Indigent matters; The Board signed two Certificates of Approval, three Notice of Liens and Applications for Medically Indigent Matters, two Release of Medically Indigent Liens, two Orders of Dismissals and one Finding of Facts, Conclusions of Law and Decision in Case.

Executive Session re: Indigent Matters; two cases presented and the Board approved five Notices of Lien and Application for Medically Indigent Benefits.

July 29, 2013: Approvals: Minutes from July 22, 2013, nine CSI Residency Applications, Beer and Liquor Licenses, acceptance and signing of a Homeland Security Grant, a letter prepared by Prosecutor Barrus to go to attorneys in the Mini-Cassia Area announcing the opening for CASA Guardian Ad Litem services, Fair and Rodeo Special Event Contract, Resolution No. 2013-015, Resolution No. 2013-016, sign contract amendment between CCSO and Idaho Department of Health and Welfare and ratify a letter signed by Chairman Crane on comments against closure of roads in the Curlew/Deep Creek TMP/EA. Executive Session re: Indigent Matters; one case presented and the Board signed two Certificates of Denial, two Notice of Lien and Applications for Medically Indigent Benefits, five Releases of Medically Indigent Liens and one Utilization Management Review on a CAT case.
