TOXIC INHALANTS

5-7-1: **USE PROHIBITED:** No person shall breathe, inhale, or drink any compound, liquid, chemical or other substance containing toluol, hexane, trichloroethylene, acetone, toluene, ethyl acetate, methyl ethyl ketone, trichloroethane, isopropanol, methyl isobutyl ketone, methyl cellosolve acetate, cyclohexanone, pentachlorophenol, petroleum ether, benzene, ethylene dichloride, or any other substance for the purpose of inducing a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, giddiness, paralysis, euphoria, exhilaration, or in any manner changing, distorting or disturbing the auditory, visual or nervous processes. (Ord. 2-77, 6-27-1977)

5-7-2: **SALE PROHIBITED:** No person shall sell, or offer to sell, to any other person any container of substance containing a solvent having the property of releasing toxic vapors or fumes, if he has cause to suspect that the product sold, or offered for sale, will be in violation of section 5-7-1 of this chapter, and no person shall possess any substance to be used in violation of the provisions of section 5-7-1 of this chapter. (Ord. 2-77, 6-27-1977)

5-7-3: **EXCEPTION:** The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to the use or inhalation of anesthesia when administered or prescribed for medical or dental purposes. (Ord. 2-77, 6-27-1977)

5-7-4: **PENALTY:** Whoever violates the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable as set forth in section 1-4-1 of this code. (Ord. 2-77, 6-27-1977; amd. 2003 Code)
