Shall the Board of Trustees of Joint School District No. 418 be authorized to incur an indebtedness and issue the general obligation school bonds of the District in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$5,400,000, to become due in such installments as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees, the final installment to fall due within thirty (30) years from the date of the bonds, for the purpose of financing the costs of construction of new elementary school facilities and renovation and improvement of existing school facilities, including all related equipment and other property necessary to maintain and operate said facilities, together with related costs and fees, all as provided in the resolution of the Board of Trustees adopted on January 13, 2014?

The following information is required by Section 34-439, Idaho Code.

The total existing indebtedness of the District, including interest accrued as of March 11, 2014, is \$281,299.26. The interest rate anticipated on the proposed bonds based on current market rates is 4.01% per annum. The anticipated interest rate is expected not to exceed 5.50% per annum. The total amount to be repaid over the life of the proposed bonds, principal and interest, based on the anticipated interest rate, is estimated to be \$9,362,879.13, of which \$5,400,000 is principal and \$3,962,879.13 is interest.
